

TEACHER'S RESPONSIBILITIES TO STUDENTS POLICY #9003

Teachers shall follow the prescribed courses of study and enforce the rules and regulations of the school district, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, and the State Board of Education, maintaining and rendering the appropriate records and reports.

Teachers shall have the right and it shall be their duty to direct and control, within reasonable limits, the studies of their pupils, taking into due consideration the individual differences among pupils. However, all pupils shall receive instruction in such prescribed courses of study as are required by law and regulations.

Teachers are required to make due preparation daily for their duties. Such preparation to include attendance at teacher's meetings and other such professional work contributing to efficient school services as may be required by the Board of Directors.

Teachers shall be responsible for the evaluation of each pupils' educational growth and development and for making periodic reports to parents and guardians and to the designated school administrator. Teachers and other certified personnel are required to be at their respective schools for the benefit of pupils and patrons at least 30 minutes after the closing of school in the afternoon. Use by any certificated person of habit forming drugs without pharmaceutical prescription by a doctor of medicine licensed to practice in the state of Washington or of any alcoholic beverage on the school premises or at a school sponsored activity off the school premises shall constitute sufficient cause for dismissal.
