

SPECIAL EDUCATION AND RELATED SERVICES FOR ELIGIBLE STUDENTS

The Star School District recognizes that students whose disabilities adversely impact educational performance and who require specially designed instruction have potential for improving educational performance when they receive special education and related services tailored to fit their needs.

Each eligible special education student in the District will be afforded a full education opportunity. This goal will be met consistent with the state’s goals through ensuring the provision of a free appropriate public education.

The District shall comply with state and federal requirements for special education. The Superintendent shall develop procedures consistent with state and federal laws and rules

Not all students with disabilities are eligible for special education services. The needs of each student will be addressed individually and provided appropriate accommodations or modifications required under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, and the Washington laws against discrimination.
